- Story Hour is intended to be an independent experience for your child. A goal of this class is for your child to feel comfortable participating independently.

Parents/Caregivers are welcome to stay when needed, if your child needs extra assistance or supervision. Please speak with the library staff member leading the class if you have any questions or concerns.
