Note 7: Firefighters accrue 16 hours a month in sick leave and accrue vacation leave at a rate dependent on length of service (12 hours a month starting, maximum 24 hours of month).						
Note 8: Police Officers accrue 8 hours a month in sick leave and accrue vacation time at a rate dependent on length of service (6.67 hours a month starting, maximum of 13.33 a month).
