- Please be on time! If you arrive late and the door is already closed, please join us as quietly as possible.
- Since this is an interactive class for toddlers and the adults who accompany them, other arrangements must be made for siblings.
- So your child can fully concentrate and participate in the activities, the library encourages parents and children to minimize the use of any distracting activities or items during the structured story hour. We also ask that parents and caregivers silence their cell phones while in the Story Hour room.
- Occasionally we have snacks during Story Hour. Food is only allowed during Story Hour when it is part of the scheduled activity. Please bring a note to the first session if your child has any food allergies.
