

Complete all 6 reading logs to earn an extra 10 Book Bucks & choose a free book to keep from the **Book Bonanza**.


Pick up your Book Bucks and claim your prizes from the Children's Department anytime between May 30 and August 6. Be sure to spend all your Book Bucks before the program ends!
